

Community Involvement Hours Update

Changes for the 2020-2021 School Year

2020-21 Graduates

For students graduating in the 2020-21 school year, the requirement has been adjusted to a minimum of 20 hours.

All Students in the 2020-21 School Year

More flexible options are available for community involvement hours.
(At the principal's discretion):

1. Students may be allowed to earn hours during the time allotted for the school day, or duties normally performed in the home.

Examples include walking a younger child to and from school, helping younger siblings with schoolwork, babysitting a sibling so that a parents/caregivers can work from home, do chores such as cleaning up, raking leaves, prepare family meals to support parents that are working from home.

2. Students aged 14 or older can count a maximum of 10 hours from paid employment. Students counting paid employment will be required to complete a reflection exercise indicating how their work contributed to the service for others.
